

SUSTAINING THE HUMANITIES THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (SHARP) GRANT

ORGANIZATION	AWARD AMOUNT	PURPOSE
Capitol Bop	\$20,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to maintain critical staff support such as their managing director and modernize and repair outdated web infrastructure including their webzine and video documentation technology.
Critical Exposure	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to help implement new program plans for the fall semester and reconnect with school partners to rebuild our In-School Programs
Day Eight	\$20,000	Day Eight's programs, revenue, and expenses
DC Arts and Humanities Education Collaborative	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to cover staff salaries and contractor expenses.
Dumbarton Arts and Education	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to train more teaching artists in our Dancing With Babies™ program and restore Inspired Child programming.
Heurich House Museum	\$30,000	This grant will fund the museum's Education Manager staff position to deliver humanities educational programming to the public.
Historical Society of DC	\$40,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to support its Library and Collections, its partnership with the Carnegie Library, and fund a new position for a person with a core expertise in museum learning to deliver on-site field trips.
Hola Cultura	\$20,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to contract fees and stipends related to S.P.E.L. program and online programs.
President Lincoln's Cottage	\$40,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to fund payroll of our humanities professionals, specifically their Museum Program Associates (paid tour guides) and educational programming staff.

Live It Learn	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to purchase and update materials and resources and staff salaries to prepare for virtual, in-person, or in a hybrid programming models.
One Common Unity	\$40,000	The SHARP grant would help cover overhead salary costs for several staff and for newly developed activities. This includes partial salary support for two Fly By Light program facilitators, who plan and conduct all the programming. It also includes the multimedia documentary project that the Performance Troupe is seeking to produce.
One World Education	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will support the general operating costs needed to sustain and expand its in-school, after-school, and adult literacy programs for local DC area students and schools.
Project Create	\$30,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to expand our programmatic offerings and introduce students to Playback Theater, a form of improvisational theater often used as a tool for positive change and community-building through personal storytelling. Project Create will partner with John Johnson, who is native Washingtonian and Ward 8 resident, to offer a Playback Theater Program in 2022 for youth ages 16 – 24.
Reading Partners	\$40,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to support general operating expenses, such as personnel and Take Reading with You books needed to implement our program, especially as we seek to expand our program.
Street Sense	\$30,000	SHARP Grant will be used to provide general support for our editorial program, specifically for editorial staff salaries and benefits.
The MusicianShip	\$40,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to provide a portion of our Senior Community Engagement Manager and our Administrative Supervisor salaries.
WNDC Educational Foundation	\$20,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to partially support rent and utilities as specified in our lease, our accountant, communications and IT, and a graphic designer for our 2022 women’s history calendar, as well as support for an accessibility consultant.
Zora Neale Hurston/Richard Wright Foundation	\$20,000	The SHARP Grant will be used to help underwrite our Literary Fellow position which we had to eliminate during the pandemic.
